


NCPCR success stories

Acid-attack victim of a Govt. Senior Secondary School, provided Medical attention (case no. 71129)

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights took suo-motu cognizance of the matter which appeared in the news paper, 'Tribune', Delhi in March, 2016. It was about acid-attack on five school girls from Government Senior Secondary School, Dera Baba Nanak, Punjab. The Commission wrote to SSP, Gurdaspur, Punjab to take urgent appropriate action in the matter.

The victims have since been provided adequate medical treatment and all the accused have been arrested.
