NCPCR'S INTERVENTION RESULTS IN RECOVERY OF KIDNAPPED MINOR GIRL OF A DOMSTIC HELP.

NCPCR received a request for intervention in a case where a girl child of 13 years, a student of class 6th class from a very poor family background (her mother works as a domestic help) was found missing from NOIDA on 10th February, 2017. Though the poor mother had filed FIR at the concerned police station of NOIDA (UP), the family had an apprehension that the police may not be serious and trace the girl belonging to such a poor family background.

NCPCR took up the matter with the District Magistrate of Gautam Budh Nagar for immediate action and directed him to recover the minor girl. Gautam Budh Nagar police informed NCPCR that the girl was recovered and, after her statement was recorded under section 164 of IPC was entrusted to her mother. The court sent the kidnapper to jail on 3rd April, 2017. Thus the intervention of NCPCR resulted in quick recovery (within 30 days from the date when the cognizance was taken by the Commission) of a minor girl from the clutches of kidnappers and restored her to her mother.
