"Come Together, We Can Stop Child Labour"

- ❖ Child labour is an illegal activity and social crime.
- ❖ No child (till the age of 14) shall be employed or permitted to work in any occupation or process, it is a punishable offence.
- ❖ No adolescent (between the age of 14 to 18) shall be employed to work in any hazardous occupations or process.
- Contravention of the provision of section 3 of the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2016 is;
 - Punishable with imprisonment for six months to two years
 - Or punishable with fine twenty thousand to fifty thousand rupees
 - Or with both.
- ❖ Do not keep quiet. If you see child labour, complain immediately to the concerned authorities.
 - Labour Department / Labour Inspector,
 - District Collector Office,
 - Police (100),
 - CHILDLINE (1098),
 - Child Welfare Committee
- **❖** You can make verbal or written complaint to the above mentioned authorities.
- ❖ Child labour is a cognizable offense. Any citizen can complain to police.
- ❖ Your complaint will be kept confidential.
- ❖ It may prove instrumental in saving a child from child labour.
- ❖ If someone does not listen to your complaint, then you can contact at National Commission for Protection of Child Rights.
