

NCPDR RESCUES 10 TRAFFICKED MINOR GIRLS FROM SIWAN DISTRICT OF BIHAR

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPDR) received information regarding trafficking of 10 minor girls to Siwan District of Bihar. Based on the information received, NCPDR swiftly intervened and directed an immediate rescue operation to Superintendent of Police, Siwan based on which a rescue operation was undertaken by the local police in coordination with the AHTU and NGO representatives.

Key Highlights of the Rescue Operation

- ↳ 10 trafficked minor girls rescued from suspected exploitation in orchestra groups.
- ↳ The girls were allegedly trafficked from different States and forced to perform obscene dances and subjected to exploitation.
- ↳ The rescue was conducted through coordinated efforts of Siwan Police, Anti Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU), Women Police Teams, District Child Protection Unit (DCPU), Rescue Foundation, Mumbai.
- ↳ The rescued children have been produced before the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) for appropriate rehabilitation and restoration measures.
