

NCPCR issues notice to Chhattisgarh on death of tribal girls

RAIPUR: Taking cognizance over deaths of two tribal girls who died at Bijapur district after consuming flavoured milk under state government's Amrit Scheme, the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), New Delhi has issued a notice to secretary, department of women and child development, to take the matter seriously and launch a special investigation in the case.

NCPCR member Yashwant Jain told TOI that the department has been directed to submit a detailed report to the commission within ten days in this regards.

As per the Sections of 14 of Protection of Child Rights Act 2005, all the incidents related to violation of rights of children or keeping them away from their rights demands for immediate attention and is a matter of investigation, hence, NCPCR has asked concerned department to take matter seriously.
