

Child-tracking software launched

BANGALORE, DHNS: A software that compiles data of children across the State 'Our Child Our Progress,' was launched by the Karnataka State Commission for Protection of Child Rights chairperson Umesh Aradhya in the City, recently.

The child-tracking software, jointly developed by Child Rights Trust (CRT), a non-governmental organisation, in association with Every Child and Hooduku IT Solutions, will compile age-

wise details of children up to 18 years, including their religion, caste and disability.

Aradhya said: "This is a very good initiative which will surely help the cause of children. However, we should ensure that the data will not be accessible to wrong hands."

Child Rights Trust Executive Director Vasudeva Sharma said that the software would supplement the softwares being used by the Sarva Shiksha

Abhiyaan, Department of Women and Child and Health department.
