Respected Madam,

I joined the esteemed National Commission for Protection of Child Rights as an intern on 18 June 2013. I was lucky enough to have the esteemed mentorship of Ms. DIPA DIXIT, hon'ble Member of the Commission. I was overawed with her vision, rich experience and expertise in Juvenile Justice, Child Labour, Corporal Punishment, Education (right to education) and specially in regard to protection of Child Rights. I am extremely thankful to Ms. DIPA DIXIT for her unstinted support in clearing any doubts at any point of time. These 16 weeks in the Commission have been a very learning experience which will help in my academics and help me contribute better to the society.

I was given an opportunity to have an overview of the court matters of all High Courts and Supreme Court of India in which NCPCR is a party. It gave me an insight understanding of the perception and working of The Commission, and also understanding the manner in which the children in the country are being exploited in the various forms. It also provided me an opportunity to understand the hierarchy, purpose, functioning and direction of The Commission.

I had a wonderful experience under the stewardship of Mr. Binod Kumar Sahu (former registrar), Mr. Raman Gaur (registrar) and Mr. Parminder Singh (legal consultant) with regard to court cases, affidavits, legal research, current status of cases, date of hearing and regarding further action which has to be taken in cases. They were very supportive, patient and helpful in clearing all my doubts during my internship in The

I also attended a meeting of chairpersons of all State Commission for Protection of Child Rights. This meeting was organised with an objective to evolve a shared forum for better coordination between NCPDR and SCPCR's. During the course of discussions some common issues which need to be pursued were :

- Monitoring of children homes and the barriers in the effective delivery of services in these homes.
- Monitoring of children admitted in school under Economically Weaker Section (EWS category), as per the Right To Education Act, 2009.
- Education of migrant workers children

It was also decided that the joint NCPDR - SCPCR's platform would be used for sharing a best practises for sharpening the monitoring mechanism and fine tuning the quasi judicial intervention of SCPCR's and NCPDR. Getting a first hand experience of this meeting has definitely added to my knowledge. I observed and took down the important points to have a better understanding of the perspective of the issues.

I visited Tihar Jail twice with other panel members in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court Dated 11/05/2012. I had a chance to be a part of this visit as an intern in NCPDR, as per the direction issued by Hon'ble High Court, vide order dated 01/08/2013, to the jail visiting panel to visit all the jails in delhi within next four weeks and submit the lists of identified probable juveniles to DLSA for necessary up. On my visit, I had interaction with inmates of Tihar jail and I prepared the list of identified probable juveniles. I learned that in many cases juveniles are presented as adults and are punished with same punishments. In this event I learned how to provide justice to those juveniles. who are kept in the adult jails. I have also prepared the list of identified probable juveniles for other panel members who has visited the jail and helped in compilation of that list. The same has been forward to DLSA for further work.

I have also prepared a list of court cases with reference to the letter received from Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD) for knowing the ongoing matters in national commission for protection of child rights. I assisted Mr. Raman Gaur (Registrar) in maintaining the list and calling the concerned Advocates for knowing the current status of the cases.

I assisted Mr. Raman Gaur (Registrar) in the verbination of the proceedings of the NCPDR in their internal matters and helped him in writing by watching videos of the proceedings.

I had also an opportunity to go through some more case files and had interaction/

discussion with various other staff in the commission which further enhance my knowledge and overview. Work culture in the commission is the quality to imbibe and follow for further development of the interns.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to Mrs. DIPA DIXIT, other members of the staff of the commission and support staff for their contribution in enhancing my knowledge, perception, development, attitude towards understanding aims, objectives and functioning of the commission.

On completing the internship tenure of 16 weeks with NCPCR. I have developed a relationship with the Commission in the days to come I will be too glad to be associated with NCPCR.
