EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) has been set up by the Ministry of Women and Child Development as a Statutory Body of Government of India in March 2007 under the Commissions for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005, to protect, promote and defend Child Rights in the country.

NCPCR invites Applications from suitable candidates for the following positions on contract basis :

I. Media Consultant

II. Sr. Technical Expert (STE), Technical Expert (TE) and Jr. Technical Expert (JTE) in the following areas -

- (i) Child Health, Care, Welfare or Child Development
- (ii) Child Labour or Children in Distress
- (iii) Child Psychology or Sociology
- (iv) Juvenile Justice
- (v) Law relating to Children
- (vi) Education

NCPCR will prepare and maintain a Panel of selected candidates (which would remain valid for a period of 2 years) for filling up of the relevant positions, which may arise from time to time.

How to apply: Interested candidates may log on www.ncpcr.gov.in for application format and terms of reference. The Application along with updated CV and documents (in support of essential qualification/experience should reach the **Member Secretary, NCPCR, 5th Floor, Chanderlok Building, 36, Janpath, New Delhi - 110001** (by speed post as well as through e-mail to baldev.ncpcr@nic.in clearly indicating the position applied for) within 21 days from the date of advertisement. Candidates sending their applications through email must submit a copy of their application, along with copies of requisite certificates, in PDF version. Those who want to apply for more than one position, are required to send separate application for each position. **Candidates who have already applied in response to our advertisement dated 14th September, 2013, need not apply again.**
