Report on NCPCR's participation in Legal Service Camp organised by DLSA on 03/02/2018

A legal awareness camp was organized by DLSA on 03.02.2018 at Kendriya Vidyalaya, Vigyan Vihar, Delhi. It was a unique and informative initiative by them. The camp provided an opportunity to get in touch with various stakeholders relating to Child Rights such as media, school teachers, police authorities and social activists.



NCPCR put up a stall in DLSA legal service camp. Visitors were oriented on Child Rights issues and POCSO e-box by showing documentary movies, pamphlets and hand outs. The staff deputed by NCPCR also answered the queries of visitors. The printed material of the Commission was of great help in making people understand the basic functions of the Commission and how complaints about Child Rights violation could be addressed to the Commission.

Justice Geeta Mittal, Hon'ble Chief Justice of Delhi High Court was the Chief Guest on this occasion. During the visit of the NCPCR stall she briefly discussed about the functioning of NCPCR and urged that other authorities should work together with NCPCR for safety and security of our children.

The interaction with police authorities was also of great significance as they talked about the practical problems being faced by them in implementation of POCSO Act.
