Recovery of two minor girls who ran away from a Children's Home of Kanker (Chhattisgarh)

NCPCR took suo-motu cognizance of a news item which stated that two minor girls aged 14 years and 16 years ran away from a Children's Home situated at a village at Kanker (Chhattisgarh). The news item also mentioned absence of a guard at that time. NCPCR asked District Magistrate to investigate the matter and have the girls restored. The District Administration has informed about the recovery of the girls. Chhattisgarh Govt. have also informed NCPCR that the registration of the Home was cancelled due to irregularities noticed during the enquiry and pending the transfer of the Home to any other competent NGO, the District Administration is running the Home.

Thus, NCPCR's intervention has led to recovery and restoration of the 2 minor girls and has also resulted in better running of the Home."
